

## **George P. Shultz Award for Excellence to OSAC**

### **AWARD PURPOSE:**

The George P. Shultz Award for Excellence to OSAC is an International Security Foundation initiative - separate and distinct from any U.S. Government or State Department award programs. This is a vehicle for the private sector constituents of OSAC to recognize exceptional performance by a U.S. Department of State employee or group, or a private sector individual or group who has made a significant contribution to enhancing the ability of American organizations to protect their personnel, assets, information, intellectual property or business operations overseas.

### **AWARD PROCESS:**

1. OSAC constituents are encouraged to make an award nomination at any time.
2. Nominations should be submitted to the ISF executive Director, Peggy O'Neill at [peggyoneill@isf4osac.org](mailto:peggyoneill@isf4osac.org).
3. The ISF Board of Directors will perform the review of nominations submitted to the Executive Director. As appropriate, and when available, the ISF Board of Directors will supplement nominations with additional information.
4. The ISF Board of Directors will consider all nominations and select a recipient to receive the award.
5. The Award will be presented as part of the annual ISF Dinner program.
6. All costs associated with the Award will be paid by the International Security Foundation.

### **NOMINATION:**

The nomination should cite specific examples of how the nominated individual or group demonstrated exceptional commitment to the goal of helping American organizations protect their personnel, assets, information, intellectual property or operations overseas.

### **AWARD:**

The ISF Board of Directors will determine an appropriate memento or representation for this award.
