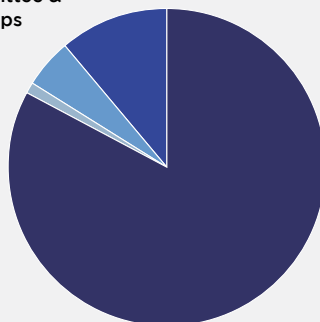

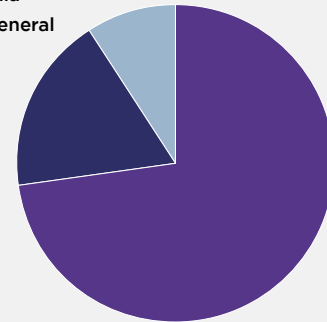
2022 ISF SOURCES OF REVENUE
